### Phase-II: Main Examination:

Main Examination will consist of Objective Tests for 200 marks and Descriptive Test for 50 marks. Both the Objective and Descriptive Tests will be online. Candidates will have to answer the Descriptive Test by typing on the computer. The Descriptive Test will be administered immediately after completion of the Objective Test.

**(b) Descriptive Test:** The Descriptive Test of 30 minutes duration with two questions for 50 marks will be a Test of English Language (Letter Writing & Essay).

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Qualification:** Graduation in any discipline from a recognized University or any equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Central Government. Those who are in the Final Year/ Semester of their Graduation may also apply provisionally subject to the condition that, if called for interview, they will have to produce proof of having passed the graduation examination on or before 31.08.2019
- Age Limit:** Not below 21 years and not above 30 years as on 01.04.2019
- Relaxation in Upper age limit:**
  - Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe: 5 Years
  - Other Backward Classes : 3 Years
  - Persons With Disabilities (PWD)(ST/SC) :15 Years
  - Persons With Disabilities (PWD)(OBC) : 13 Years
  - Persons With Disabilities (PWD)(GEN) : 10 Years
  - Ex-Servicemen: 5 Years

### Final Selection

The marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination (Phase-I) will not be added for preparing the final merit list for selection. Only the marks obtained in Main Examination (Phase-II), both in the Objective Test and the Descriptive Test, will be added to the marks obtained in GE & Interview (Phase-III) for preparing the final merit list. The candidates will have to qualify both in Phase-II and Phase-III separately. Marks secured by the candidates in the Main Examination (out of 250 marks) are converted to out of 75 marks and Group Exercises & Interview scores of candidate (out of 50 marks) are converted to out of 25 marks. The final merit list is arrived at after aggregating (out of 100) converted marks of Main Examination and Group Exercises & Interview.
